One of the exclusive candidate for the office of Lambardar of village Petwar, Tehsil Narnaund, District Hisar, the District Collector Hisar vide order dated 07.06.2011 while considering the Naksha Lambardari found that all the applicants including the petitioner are ineligible and thus ordered afresh Munadi. The order was taken in appeal by two candidates namely Ajit Singh and Jogender and their appeal was also dismissed vide order dated 13.09.2011 by reaffirming the findings of the Collector. Two revisions were filed by the two exclusive appellants which have also been dismissed. However, only one of the exclusive applicant has filed the present writ petition.

After making submissions, the counsel for the petitioner prays

for permission to withdraw the present writ petition to enable him to compete afresh in the light of fresh proclamation to be made.

In view of the above, present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
