AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

It is the contention of counsel for the petitioner that vide order dated 07.01.2015 (Annexure P-10), the Chief Divisional Retail Sales Manager, Hissar Divisional Office, withdrew the letter of intent dated 10.12.2012 issued in favour of the petitioner for setting up a retail outlet dealership at On Farmana-Dorar Road upto 2 KM from Farmana Bus Stand on the ground that the experience certificate submitted by her was false. Against the said order a statutory appeal dated 09.02.2015 (Annexure P-11) was preferred by the petitioner to the Executive Director, Delhi and Haryana State Office, World Trade Centre, Babar Road, New Delhi-respondent No.3 but no decision thereon till date has been taken or conveyed to the petitioner.

Counsel contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be

satisfied if a direction is issued to the Executive Director, Delhi and Haryana State Office, World Trade Centre, Babar Road, New Delhi-respondent No.3 to consider and decide the appeal filed by the petitioner, within some specified time.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner and without going into the merit of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to the Executive Director, Delhi and Haryana State Office, World Trade Centre, Babar Road, New Delhi-respondent No.3 to decide the appeal expeditiously preferably within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
