By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the respondents to count the military service rendered during the 2nd National Emergency from 03.12.1971 to 25.03.1977 for increment and pension as per the Govt., notification dated 15.10.2009 (Annexure P-1).

The learned counsel contends that the case of the petitioner is covered by CWP No. 15678 of 2013 (Annexure P-2).

Keeping in view the assertion raised, without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to examine the case of the petitioner and in case the examination reaches to a conclusion that the case of the petitioner is covered by Annexure P-2, in that eventuality, the necessary benefits be released to the petitioner within six weeks thereafter.
