AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is neither wanting initiation of any criminal proceeding against respondent No.2 nor is she claiming any compensation nor highlighting any negligence on the part of the said respondent. He, however, contends that respondent No.4 being a public servant should have properly attended the patient who had been brought to the said respondent and the language which has been used, as has been highlighted in the representation/complaint dated 26.05.2015 (Annexure P-1) depicts, should not be used.

Counsel contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Director General Health Services, Haryana-respondent 2 and Chief Medical Officer, Government Hospital, Sector-6, Panchkula-respondent No.3 to look into the said complaint and take appropriate steps that may deem fit/ proper to the facts and circumstances of the case.

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In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to the Director General Health Services, Haryana-respondent 2 and Chief Medical Officer, Government Hospital, Sector-6, Panchkula-respondent No.3 to look into the matter and take appropriate steps in accordance with law, if requires, within a period of six weeks, from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
