Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the details of ₹ 1,72,702/- paid to the petitioner have been furnished. In case still any grievance regarding calculation remains, the petitioner will file a representation to the competent authority which may be decided and in case it is found that any other amount is due, the same be directed to be paid.

Learned counsel for the respondents does not have any objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

Considering the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to move a representation to the competent authority, in case there is any error in calculation of ₹ 1,72,702/- paid to the petitioner and in case on verification of record, it is found that any further amount is due to the petitioner, the same shall be paid.

The matter shall be decided by the competent authority within four months from the date of receipt of the representation.
