Through this application, Dy. Director, Secondary Education, Haryana, Shiksha Sadan, Sector-5, Panchkula is sought to be impleaded as respondent No.5.

In view of the averments made in the application duly supported by an affidavit and after hearing learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner, I deem it proper to allow the application. Accordingly Dy. Director, Secondary Education, Haryana, Shiksha Sadan, Sector-5, Panchkula is ordered to be impleaded as respondent No.5 in the main writ petition. The amended memo of parties filed alongwith the application is ordered to be taken on record.

Civil miscellaneous application stands disposed of.

Main case

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, he would be satisfied if the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.5 to take a decision on the objections dated 08.06.2015 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioner.

I find the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner to be reasonable.

Accordingly, at this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.5 to take decision on the objections dated 08.06.2015 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioner by passing a speaking order and after affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, preferably within four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Needless to add that the decision so taken be communicated to the petitioner and if the decision is not to the satisfaction of the petitioner, she would be at liberty to challenge the same, in accordance with law.
