By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the respondents to pay all the retiral benefits of the petitioner.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner had moved a representation dated 27.04.2015 (Annexure P-2), however, the same has not been decided so far. He further contends that no inquiry/charge sheet is pending against the petitioner.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to decide the representation, Annexure P-2, by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
