AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

It is the contention of the counsel for the petitioners that Amandeep Kaur is a minor and is being forced by her parents respondents 4 and 5 as also by her grand-mother respondent 6 to marry some person. He contends that she does not want to marry the said person and therefore approached the Senior Superintendent of Police, SBS Nagar-respondent No.2, vide representation dated 01.07.2015 (Annexure P-3).

Counsel contends that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Senior Superintendent of Police, SBS Nagar-respondent No.2 to look into the representation dated 01.07.2015 (Annexure P-3) and take steps, in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of, without going into merits of the case or commenting thereon, with directions to the Senior Superintendent of Police, SBS Nagar-respondent No.2 to look into the representation dated 01.07.2015 (Annexure P-3) and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.
