By way of the instant writ petition, under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the respondents to release the retiral benefits along with interest @ 18% per annum.

The learned counsel contends that he will be satisfied in case, the competent authority is directed to decide the legal notice dated 27.02.2015 (Annexure P-3) served by the petitioner for the redressal of his grievance, which has not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, which is stated to be respondent No.2 to consider and decide the legal notice, Annexure P-3, by passing a speaking order, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
