ARUN PALLI J. (Oral)

Having argued the matter at some length, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he be permitted to withdraw the instant petition, so as to enable the petitioners to represent the respondents in the first instance, as regards their grievance. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that let this petition itself be treated as a representation and he would submit the same for consideration of the authorities within a week from today and a direction be issued to the respondents to consider and decide the same within a specified time.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, if any, representation is indeed submitted by the petitioners, as regards their grievance set out in this

petition within a period of three weeks from today, the same shall be considered and decided within a further period of six weeks thereafter, strictly in accordance with law. This order shall not constitute any expression of opinion on merits of the case.
