**CWP No.13463 of 2015**

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner contends that the writ petition was initially filed on 01.07.2015 and the case came up for hearing on 09.07.2015 but the same was adjourned for today. He states that during the interregnum, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala, has re-assessed the threat perception to the petitioner and has recommended for providing security by communication dated 06.07.2015, which is addressed to the Additional Director General of Police (Security), Punjab. He further states that the petitioner has been granted one additional PSO from the Armed Battalion by order dated 06.07.2015 (Annexure P-12). He states that as of now the petitioner has two PSOs. Learned senior counsel for the petitioner states that earlier the protection, which was provided to the

petitioner, consisted of six police officers, which was reduced to one PSO and now as per the latest situation, it is two PSOs. He further states that the petitioner is ready to bear the expenses for any additional security, which may be provided to him by the State of Punjab.

Learned counsel contends that the petitioner shall make a detailed representation to the Additional Director General of Police (Security), Punjab, within a period of 15 days from today, which may be directed to be considered and decided keeping in view the recommendation dated 06.07.2015 made by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala, within some specified time.

In view of the statement made by learned senior counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a detailed representation to the Additional Director General of Police (Security), Punjab, within a period of 15 days.

If such a representation is made, the same shall be considered and decided expeditiously and preferably within a period of four weeks of submission of such representation.
