Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for quashing the notice bearing No.ME.12/66 dated 12.04.2012 (Annexure P-7) and notice bearing No.ME/12/249 dated 17.05.2012 (Annexure P-8) served by the Executive Engineer, Municipal Corporation, Ambala whereby the order compounding the construction of Chhajja projection in front of house of petitioner has been revoked and the petitioner has been directed not to initiate any sort of construction in the house.

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In pursuance of notice of motion, the respondent appeared. However, the respondent did not file any reply.

Learned counsel for respondent-Municipal Corporation, Ambala states that notice has been issued and fresh order will be passed after hearing the petitioner.

In view of statement made by learned counsel for respondent-Municipal Corporation, Ambala, instant petition is disposed of with a direction that fresh order be passed in accordance with law after affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioner. Till passing of order, no action will be taken.

CM-9556-2014 filed by applicant-Ram Parkash has been rendered infructuous.
