AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner, after his retirement on 28.02.2015, has not been granted any benefit including the provisional pension till date. He contends that the petitioner had been approaching the respondents for grant of the grade pay of ₹5000/-, whereas, he is being granted the grade pay of ₹4400/- of C&V cadre other than the Language Teacher although he had retired as a Hindi Teacher. He contends that the petitioner served a notice through counsel dated 30.03.2015 (Annexure P-14) upon the respondents which till date has not been responded to.

Counsel contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondents 2, 3 and 5 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 30.03.2015 (Annexure P-14) served by the petitioner within some specified time.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of without going into

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the merits of the case or commenting thereon, with directions to the Director Public Instruction (Secondary Education) Punjab-respondent No.2, District Education Officer (S.E.), Ropar, District Ropar-respondent No.3 and Accountant General, Punjab-respondent No.5 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 30.03.2015 (Annexure P-14) within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential benefits be released to him, in accordance with law, within a further period of three weeks. The decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
