SURYA KANT, J. [ORAL]

The petitioner who belongs to General Category, questions the order dated 03.06.2015 of Additional Deputy Commissioner, Bhiwani whereby Ward No. 12 has been reserved for Scheduled Caste category.

Relying upon the averments made in the written statement as well as on instructions, it is stated by learned State Counsel that the District Administration followed the Government instructions dated 20.11.2014 read with supplementary instructions dated 07.05.2015 and held a draw of lots for reservation of the seats for Scheduled Caste [Women] and the wards were allocated to different categories accordingly as per those instructions.

It is stipulated in the instructions that reservation of seats shall be 'rotated' firstly amongst the villages having largest population of scheduled castes and then those having second largest population of that reserved category till the last.

Those instructions are not under challenge by the petitioner.

The impugned order having been passed in deference to such instructions, no interference is called for. Even on merits, the petitioner can not be permitted to build up his case by questioning the manner of reserving seats for 'women' as he does not belong to that reserved category.

Dismissed.
