**AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)**

It is the contention of the counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner was assigned four different works on 01.07.2013, details of which have been mentioned in para-2 of the writ petition. The work was completed on 30.11.2013 and the amount due, qua Work Nos. 1 to 3, has been released but the security amount i.e. ₹ 2,92,000/-, till date, has not been refunded. As regards Work No. 4, the balance amount along with security i.e. ₹ 42,76,883/- is still pending, for which the payment is to be made by the Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Bagha Purana, District

Moga-respondent No. 3.

Petitioner has served a notice through counsel dated 16.05.2015 (Annexure P-2), to which no response has been received. Counsel for the petitioner, therefore, contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Bagha Purana, District Moga-respondent No. 3 to release the balance payment and security within some specified time.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Bagha Purana, District Moga-respondent No. 3 to release the balance payment and security within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of the order. The consequential benefits be released to the petitioner within a further period of one month.
