By way of the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners seek issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing the respondents to enter Sehat Inderaj Intkal (Correction of mutation) in their favour, on the basis of the judgment and decree dated 23.08.1999 (Annexure P-4) and judgment and decree dated 22.01.2001 (Annexure P-7).

The learned counsel contends that the petitioners, at this stage, shall be satisfied, in case, respondent No.2 is directed to consider and decide the representation filed by them (Annexure P-11).

Keeping in view the prayer made, without adverting to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, which is stated to be respondent No.2, to consider and decide the representation, Annexure P-11, by

passing a speaking order, expeditiously, preferably, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
