The sole prayer is for construction of the boundary wall raised by respondent No.5. The learned counsel submits that on account of the collapse of the boundary wall, certain residents of the village have encroached upon the land which was earlier under the pond. The petitioner had moved representation dated 15.04.2013 (Annexure P-3) for raising the construction of the boundary wall which is in the larger interest of the village community, however, he submits that despite repeated reminders, no action has been initiated so far.

Considering the fact that the issue pertains to the welfare of the whole village community, the respondent No.3 is directed to examine the matter and in case, on examination any truth is found in the assertion raised by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the remedial measures be taken as per law.
