AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court praying for issuance of a mandamus directing the official respondents to arrange for the meeting of the petitioner, who is lodged in Model Jail, Chandigarh, in FIR No.229 dated 04.06.2014 under Sections 302, 307 IPC, Police Station Mani Majra, Chandigarh, after his conviction by the trial Court on 13.02.2015, with his minor sons. The allegation against the petitioner is that he has murdered his wife. The children, who are aged 6 years and 4½ years, are presently residing with their grandparents and, therefore, they are not likely to bring the children to the Model Jail, Chandigarh, for meeting the petitioner.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has only been convicted in February, 2015, the prayer made in the present writ petition cannot be entertained at this stage.

The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
