Learned counsel for the petitioners after arguing the matter for sometime states that the registration has been denied contrary to the provisions of law.

In view of this, the remedy of application to Registrar and civil suit is available to the petitioners under Section 73 read with Section 77 of the Registration Act, 1908.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for dismissal of the petition as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioners to file the appeal.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

The appeal, if any, filed within three weeks, the

same shall be decided on merits and the objection of limitation shall not be taken into consideration, keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have been pursuing the matter in wrong form under bona fide belief.
