AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court praying for a direction declaring the action of respondents 1 and 2 as discriminatory and illegal in not allowing the relief @ ₹200/- per quintal of KMS-2009 since the paddy (PAU-201) was delivered by the petitioner for milling, which did not conform to the required specifications.

Counsel for the petitioner very fairly states that the matter has been dealt by this Court in *Civil Writ Petition No.10386 of 2012* titled as *M/s. Bansal Rice Mills and another Versus Union of India and others*, which has been decided on 16.09.2014 (Annexure P-6). He contends that against the dismissal of the writ petition, Letters Patent Appeal No.1854 of 2014 titled as *M/s. Bansal Rice Mills and another Versus Union of India and others*, was preferred, which was dismissed on 01.12.2014 (Annexure P-7).

In view of the above, the present writ petition is dismissed in same terms as in **M/s. Bansal Rice Mills and another's case** (supra).
