Learned counsel has stated that the clearance of the candidature of the petitioner has been cancelled without any reason. In this connection, he issued a legal notice dated 18.02.2015 (Annexure P-7) and that he would be satisfied at this stage if in the first instance a direction is issued to the respondent No.2 to decide the same by passing a speaking order thereon within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. Resultantly, the respondent No.2 is directed to decide the said notice by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
