AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

It is the contention of counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner, on the basis of Civil Court decree dated 21.03.2010 passed by the Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Pehowa, submitted an application/representation for incorporation of the mutation on 05.03.2013 (Annexure P-4) to the Assistant Collector Ist Grade, Pehowa, which was received in his office on the same very day. Counsel states that till date, no steps have been taken by the said respondent either accepting or rejecting the same. Request has also been submitted by the petitioner to the Deputy Commissioner, Kurukshetra, vide representation dated 06.01.2015 (Annexure P-6) but that also has not yielded any result.

Counsel contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Deputy Commissioner, Kurukshetra and Tehsildar, Pehowa, District Kurukshetra, respondent Nos.2 and 3 respectively, to pass appropriate orders within some specified time.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner and without going into the merit of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to the Deputy Commissioner, Kurukshetra and Tehsildar, Pehowa, District Kurukshetra, respondent Nos.2 and 3 respectively, to consider and decide the representation dated 06.01.2015 (Annexure P-6) by passing a speaking order within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
