This order will dispose of the aforesaid three Civil Writ Petitions since they emerge out of a common order dated 02.09.2014 (**P-9**), passed by the learned Financial Commissioner (Revenue), Punjab whereby seven Revisions of Revisions (RORs) were disposed of emerging out of a common partition proceedings between the co-sharers.

It is apparent that vide the impugned order dated 02.09.2014 (**P-9**), the learned Financial Commissioner has held the revision petitions to be not

maintainable.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioners states that two other Writ Petitions were earlier filed challenging the present order dated 02.09.2014 (**P-9**) relating to two other RORs and the same were disposed of, vide order dated 22.01.2015 passed by this Court on the ground that learned Financial Commissioner has erroneously not entertained the revisions by ignoring the amendment of Section 16 of the Punjab Revenue Act w.e.f. 28.01.2013 whereby the jurisdiction was vested with the Financial Commissioner. The said orders dated 22.01.2015 passed by this Court have been annexed with as **Annexure P-11 and Annexure P-12**.

After hearing learned Counsel for the petitioners and keeping in view the facts of the present case, it is apparent that on the date when the learned Financial Commissioner has dismissed the revision petitions as not maintainable on 02.09.2014, he was fully competent to hear and decide the revision petitions in view of vesting of jurisdiction vide amendment w.e.f. 28.01.2013.

Accordingly, the impugned order dated 02.09.2014 (**P-9**) is set aside and the matter is remanded back to the learned Financial Commissioner to decide the revision petitions on merits.

The petitioners are directed to appear before the learned Financial Commissioner on 25.03.2015.

Disposed of in the above terms.
