Prayer in the present petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to count the service rendered by the petitioner in Kendriya Vidyalaya (Central Service), towards pensionary benefits.

It is asserted that the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the ratio of law laid down by this Court in ***Er. Shyam Lal Chugh Vs. State of Punjab and others***, rendered in CWP No.3787 of 2006, decided on 18.04.2009.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to examine the case of the petitioner as to whether the it is covered by the ratio of law laid down in Er. Shyam Lal Chugh's case (supra), within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the matter is covered, in that eventuality, the consequential benefits be released to the petitioner within a period of four weeks thereafter. However, if the competent authority comes to the conclusion that the case is not covered, then a reasoned and speaking order be passed on the representation, Annexure P-5.
