This petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to release the pensionary benefits of the petitioner along with interest.

The learned counsel submits that no proceeding (civil as well as criminal), enquiry or charge-sheet are pending against the petitioner. The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner has served a legal notice, Annexure P-1, however, the same has not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to decide the legal notice, Annexure P-1, by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
