The short question involved in this case is “as to whether the Superintending Canal Officer had the jurisdiction to entertain an application of review ?”

Learned counsel for the respondents has failed to support the order of SCO passed while exercising powers of review as it has been admitted by him that no such provision is there in the Northern India Canal Drainage Act, 1873, which empowers the SCO to review its own order.

In view thereof, the order Annexure P-4 which has been passed by the SCO, Ferozepur, Circle, Ferozepur, dated 16.1.2014, is hereby set

Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that he may be allowed to challenge the order dated 28.7.2011 in accordance with law.

Needless to mention that if the law permits, the respondents may challenge the said order.
