Prayer in the present petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to grant the pay scale of Head Teacher to the petitioner by refixation of pay and pension of the petitioner on notional basis, along with arrears for the last 38 months.

It is contended that the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the ration of law laid down in CWP No.4747 of 2002, titled as Sushila Devi and others Vs. State of Haryana and others (Annexure P-7).

Having regard to the nature of the order being passed, there appears to be no necessity to call upon the respondents to file their counter replies/affidavits, at this stage.

In the circumstances, the present petition is disposed of

with a direction to the competent authority, to treat the present petition as representation and examine the case of the petitioner as to whether the it is covered by the ratio of law laid down in Annexure P-7, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order and if the answer is in affirmative, the consequential benefits be released to the petitioner within a period of two months thereafter. In the eventuality of its not being covered by Annexure P-2, the competent authority shall pass a speaking order on the representation, as per law.
