AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (Oral):

It is the contention of the counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner supplied Silver Ionization Plants, vide Invoice No.02 dated 06.04.2010 amounting to ₹3,00,508/- but the payment, till date, has not been released to the petitioner. He contends that the petitioner has served a notice through counsel dated 20.12.2014 (Annexure P-2) upon the Executive Engineer, Water Supply & Sanitation (RWS) Division, Sangrur-respondent No.5 for release of the amount alongwith interest but no response thereto has been received nor any amount has been released.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Executive Engineer, Water Supply & Sanitation (RWS) Division, Sangrur-respondent No.5 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 20.12.2014 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner within some specified time.

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In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, with directions to the Executive Engineer, Water Supply & Sanitation (RWS) Division, Sangrur-respondent No.5 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 20.12.2014 (Annexure P-2) within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential benefits be released to it, in accordance with law, within a further period of six weeks. The decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
