In this petition, petitioner has sought for directions to release pension, gratuity, ex-gratia, provident fund, leave encashment etc. along with interest. On 05.06.2014, claim of the members of the petitioner's family have been granted by a speaking order. The same is produced as Annexure R2 along with statement of objections and affidavit filed on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2. In view of the speaking order dated 05.06.2014 nothing survives in this petition.

It was noticed that ex-gratia grant, leave encashment, G.P. fund, pension/DCRG were settled belatedly for which the concerned person is entitled for interest. The respondents are directed to release interest @ 9% per annum.

Accordingly, the petition is disposed of.
