AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court, impugning the order dated 08.01.2015 (Annexure P-8) as also order dated 30.03.2015 (Annexure P-12) on the ground that the said orders are not sustainable in the light of the reports dated 01.09.2014 and 03.09.2014 submitted by the petitioner, which are from the Government Water Testing Laboratories situated at Jind and Karnal which pertain to the water sample of the tubewells installed by the Government in the fields of the petitioner.

This contention of counsel for the petitioner cannot be accepted in the light of the detailed orders passed by the competent authority which have been impugned in the present writ petition where it has been stated that the sample was collected by the Junior Engineer,

Bhimwani Khara from the spot for testing the water sample which, according

to the Beldar of the village, was bitter in taste and oily. The said samples were tested in the laboratory of the Public Health Engineering Circle, Bhiwani and the same, on test, was reported to be chemically unfit. The report of the Department of Public Health Engineering Circle, Bhiwani, clearly establishes that the water from these two tubewells, which were installed in the land of the petitioner, was not fit for drinking purposes and, therefore, there is no illegality in the orders impugned in the present writ petition, which would call for interference by this Court in exercise of its extra ordinary writ jurisdiction.

In view of above, the present writ petition stands dismissed.
