Costs imposed upon the State, vide order dated 05.05.2015, have been paid.

The present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking release of his full retiral benefits alongwith permissible allowances as also full salary for the suspension period w.e.f. 26.04.2001 to 17.01.2005.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Smt. Karuna Sharma, Superintendent in the office of Financial Commissioner, Department of Printing and Stationary, Government of Haryana, submits that the aforesaid retiral benefits of the petitioner and the issue with regard to how the suspension period of the petitioner is to be treated were hanging fire, since a charge-sheet was pending against the petitioner. He further submits that the aforesaid charge-sheet against the petitioner has since been ordered to be dropped and in furtherance thereof, retiral benefits of the petitioner would be verified, calculated and released in his favour within four months from today. He further submits that so as to how, the petitioner's suspension period is to be treated will also be considered and decided within the aforesaid period of four months.

The above statement made on behalf of the respondents, satisfies the petitioner except with regard to his claim for the grant of interest on the retiral benefits which according to him were due on 29.02.2008 i.e. the date of retirement of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to make a representation to the respondents for claiming interest after the retiral benefits are released to him. The representation so made would be considered and decided expeditiously by passing a speaking order.
