Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner had appeared in the sixth semester of LL.B-III year course in the month of May 2015 but his result was not declared by the Punjab University. In the mean time, he took entrance examination of LL.M-I year course offered by Punjabi University, Patiala on 4.07.2015 and secured 17th rank as per the result declared on 10.07.2015.

On 16.07.2015, he approached this Court in which notice of motion was issued for 22.07.2015. In the mean time, respondent No.1 was directed to allow the petitioner to appear in the interview/counselling, which was to be held on 17.07.2015, for admission in the LL.M-I year Course.

Accordingly, the petitioner was allowed by respondent No. 1 to appear in the Interview/Counselling on 17.07.2015. Result of the counselling has been declared but it has not been finalised so far.

Counsel for respondent Nos. 3 and 4 today has produced the result Gazette of 6th semester of LL.B-III year course held in May 2015 and informed the Court that the petitioner, who had appeared under R.No. 5057, Regd. No. 18009000598, has been declared pass with 61.59 % marks. It is thus, submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the only hurdle in the way of the petitioner, to secure admission in the LL.M-I year course, has been over because he has successfully completed his LL.B-III year course from the Punjab University.

In view of the aforesaid, I am of the considered opinion that the petitioner is eligible to be considered for admission to the LL.M-I year course. Hence, counsel for respondent No. 1 is directed to consider the candidature of the petitioner as well, while finalising the result.

Disposed of .
