AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been wrongly involved in the matter on the basis of the complaint (Annexure P-3) which has been submitted by respondent No.4. As per the said complaint, the allegations made therein although appeared to be serious but all are without any basis. He contends that respondent No.4 is a lady who is actually, without any resource, has been allured by the petitioner on the pretext for giving a job is wrong as respondent No.4 has a bank account even in America. He further states that she holds a valid visa for visiting America and in support of this, he has placed reliance upon Annexure P-8. That apart, he contends that the petitioner is being harassed by respondent No.5 who is the Incharge of Mahila Police Station, Baradari, District Patiala. He contends that the petitioner had already approached the Station House Officer of the Police Station by way of representation Annexure P-9 as also the Inspector General of Police,

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Patiala Zone, Patiala, vide representation dated 12.07.2015 (Annexure P-10).

Counsel states that petitioner will now approach the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala-respondent No.3 within a period of one week from today who may be directed to look into the matter and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of without going into merits of the case or commenting thereon, with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala-respondent No.3 within a period of one week from today. If the petitioner approaches the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala-respondent No.3 within the time stated above, the said respondent shall look into the matter and if some action is required to be taken, the same be taken in accordance with law.
