This petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing the respondents to take action against respondent No.5, on the complaint/representations dated 30.09.2014 and 29.04.2015 (Annexures P-1 and P-3).

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of their grievance, the petitioners have served a legal notice, Annexure P-4, however, the same has not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to decide the legal notice, Annexure P-4, expeditiously, preferably within a period of

six weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
