AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

The petitioner claims that he could not attend the Lower School Course started in 2012 because of serious illness and has prayed that he should be sent for the course now. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in this connection the petitioner has made an appeal (Annexure P-5) and at this stage the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide the said appeal within any reasonable time by passing a speaking order thereon.

I find this to be a fair request.

Resultantly this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the appeal Annexure P-5 by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Miscellaneous Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
