Learned Senior Advocate, apart from making other grievances, as has been highlighted in the present writ petition, has referred to the communication dated 24.04.2015 (Annexure P-6) addressed by the Assistant Town Planner, Zone C, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana to the Executive Engineer, Punjab State Power Corporation Limited, ATI Road, Sub Division, Gill Road, Ludhiana, which indicates that the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana, had ordered the sealing of the mobile tower installed by M/s Tata Teleservices, Industrial Area, Mohali, in House No.3474, Gali No.11, Chet Singh Nagar near Dana Mandi, Railway Crossing, Ludhiana. Although the lock has been put on the box of the tower but the electrical connection could not be disconnected as the same can only be done by the Punjab State Power Corporation Limited, which has issued the said connection. Request has thus been made to disconnect the connection of the tower so that the sealing of the mobile tower can be given effect to. He contends that no steps have been taken to comply with the said

request dated 24.04.2015 (Annexure P-6) by the Executive Engineer, Punjab State Power Corporation Limited.

Keeping in view the above, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with direction to the Executive Engineer, Punjab State Power Corporation Limited, ATI Road, Sub Division, Gill Road, Ludhiana, to take into consideration the communication dated 24.04.2015 (Annexure P-6) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
