AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court praying for issuing a writ of mandamus directing the competent authority for transferring the gun licence No.624-DM-SSA of DBBL 12 bore gun in his favour as his father, Sh.Mahavir, who had licence in his name, has expired on 25.01.2015. The application, on the death of father of the petitioner, was submitted on 20.03.2015 (Annexure P-4) to the Deputy Commissioner, Sirsa, but no decision thereon has been taken till date.

Counsel contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Deputy Commissioner, Sirsa-respondent No.2 to consider and decide the application dated 20.03.2015 (Annexure P-4) filed by the petitioner, within some specified time.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner and without going into the merit of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to the Deputy Commissioner, Sirsa-respondent No.2 to consider and decide the application dated 20.03.2015 (Annexure P-4) within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
