Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite the fact that the petitioner superannuated on 31.10.2014, vide order (Annexure P-2), no retiral benefits, whatsoever, have been paid to him.

He further submits that a legal notice has been served upon the respondents on 8.12.2014 (Annexure P-3), but it does not contain the details of the different heads of the retiral benefits payable to the petitioner and as such, this petition may be disposed of directing the respondents to treat the same as a substitute of the legal notice issued, and to take a decision thereupon, within a specified period.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority amongst the respondents, to take a decision on the contentions raised in the writ petition, by passing a speaking order, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

In case the relief sought in this petition, or any part thereof, is

found due, the same shall be released to the petitioner within a period of one month thereafter.

If, for any legally valid reasons, the relief sought by the petitioner, or any part thereof, is not found due, detailed reasons for the same shall be given in the speaking order to be passed.
