SURYA KANT, J. [ORAL]

The petitioners who are residents of village Baragarh, Block Shahjampur, Tehsil Naraingarh, District Ambala are aggrieved against the de-limitation of Wards undertaken for the purposes of ensuing Gram Panchayat elections.

Learned State Counsel submits that keeping in view the nature of relief prayed for, it is not necessary for the official respondents to file any written statement at this stage.

We have heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioners allege that while reserving different Wards for the reserved categories, the original records have been manipulated. It is their grievance that though the complaints dated 18.06.2015, 22.06.2015 and 29.06.2015 [P-1 to P-4] were made but no action is being taken by the Authorities.

Keeping in view the above-mentioned facts and circumstances, it is not necessary for us to express any views on

merits of the allegations and suffice it would be to dispose of this writ petition with a direction to the Deputy Commissioner, Ambala-cum-District Election Officer to look into the complaints, said to have been made by the petitioners and take an appropriate decision with respect to their grievance, as early as possible but well before the ensuing Gram Panchayat elections.

Disposed of. Dasti.
