For the reasons recorded, the application is allowed. The documents Annexures P-11 and P-12 are taken on record.

C.W.P. No.14232 of 2015

By this writ petition the petitioner has claimed that he is the most suitable candidate for the post of Assistant Registrar in the respondent-University but he apprehends that without considering his claim for that post because he is senior, the respondent No.3 may be clandestinely appointed even though he is not eligible.

It may be mentioned that this apprehension is not based on any material on the record. To my mind, it is inconceivable that the post of Assistant Registrar can be filled up 'clandestinely' without reference to the rules. Like any public post either this post will be filled up by open advertisement or by considering the cases of all employees by a Departmental Promotion Committee and I have no reason to believe that the respondent-University will fill up the post in any other illegal manner.

In the circumstances, the petition is dismissed at this stage.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
