AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

It is the contention of the counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner was allotted two different work orders in the month of May 2014. The total amount due to the petitioner is ₹1,03,18,362/- which has not been released to the petitioner till date. The said amount has to be released by the Executive Engineer, W/S Water Sanitation Department, Punjab, Division No.1-respondent No.3. Petitioner has approached the respondents by way of legal notice dated 27.05.2015 (Annexure P-1) which has also not been responded to.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Executive Engineer, W/S Water Sanitation Department, Punjab, Division No.1-respondent No.3 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 27.05.2015 (Annexure P-1), within some specified time.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the

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petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, with directions to the Executive Engineer, W/S Water Sanitation Department, Punjab, Division No.1-respondent No.3 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 27.05.2015 (Annexure P-1) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

In case, the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential benefits be released to him, in accordance with law, within a further period of six weeks. The decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
