The petitioner seeks quashing of impugned order dated 27.01.2014 (Annexure P-5), passed by respondent No.2, whereby, the pension being granted to the petitioner has been stopped.

It is asserted that the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the ratio of law laid down by this Court in ***Mohan Singh Vs. State of Punjab, 2013 SCC OnLine P&H 10035.***

In the circumstances, the respondents are directed to examine the matter in the light of the judgment in Mohan Singh's case (supra). The needful be done within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this judgment. In case, the claim of the petitioner is made out, the consequential relief be granted to him

within four months thereafter.
