Through this application, orders of this Court dated 28.5.2015 and 1.6.2015 (Annexures P-12 and P-13) are sought to be placed on record.

Allowed as prayed for.

Civil miscellaneous application stands disposed of.

Main case

The petitioner was working as Senior Computer Instructor with the respondent-Punjab Police Security Corporation (hereinafter referred to as “the Corporation”). His services were terminated through order dated 15.5.2015. The petitioner challenged the order of his termination through CWP No.12093 of 2015; Chaand Singh v. State of Punjab and others, which was dismissed as withdrawn by passing the following order:

“After arguing the case for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of the Court to withdraw the present petition, with liberty to the petitioner to avail his other remedies, in accordance with law.

Permission is granted.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty, as prayed for.”

Through the present writ petition, the petitioner challenges the advertisement issued by the respondent-corporation seeking applications for appointment to the post of Senior Computer Instructor. Once the services of the petitioner have been terminated, it is but natural that the respondent-corporation would seek to fill up the vacant post. This Court has not interfered with the order terminating the services of the petitioner and has granted liberty to the petitioner to seek alternative remedies.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present writ petition with liberty to raise the grievances made in the present writ petition before the alternative forum which may be chosen by the petitioner to challenge his termination.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
