By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the respondents to release the service benefits of the deceased son of the petitioner and arrears of revised pay scale, fixation of pay/pension as per revised pay scale of 01.01.2006 along with interest @ 18% per annum.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that for the redressal of her grievance, the petitioner had moved representation (Annexure P-3), however, the benefits has not been released so far.

In the circumstances, without adverting to the merit of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a liberty to the petitioner to

file a representation for redressal of her grievance before respondent No.4, who shall decide the same, by passing a speaking order, in terms of the law laid down in *The Financial Commissioner and Principal Secretary to Govt. of Haryana, Irrigation Department, Civil Secretariat, Chandigarh Vs. Hasan Singh Kanwar, 2010(1) SLR 788, Daya Singh Vs. State of Haryana, 2014(3) SCT 211 and D.D. Tewari Vs. UHBVNL, 2014(8) SCC 894*, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
