By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the respondents to register the sale deed in accordance with law.

The learned counsel contends that despite recommendations by respondent No.3, the respondent No.2 has not taken any decision. The petitioner purchased the land in an open auction and paid the auction amount.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, which is stated to be respondent No.3 to decide the letter dated 27.05.2015, Annexure P-6, by passing a speaking order, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
