Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have filed an appeal against the eviction order accompanied by an application for stay but on account of non-availability of the Joint Development Commissioner, SAS Nagar, Mohali, (exercising the powers of the Commissioner under the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961), neither the appeal nor the application for stay has been taken up for consideration.

We have heard counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the controversy, dispose of the writ petition, by directing the Joint Development Commissioner, SAS Nagar, Mohali, to take up the petitioners' application for stay and/or the appeal and pass appropriate orders on the application for stay within fifteen days from today. Dispossession of the petitioners shall remain stayed for this period of fifteen days.
