Having argued the matter at some length, learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that he be permitted to withdraw the petition, so as to enable the petitioner to represent to the respondent-authorities in the first instance, particularly when a comprehensive representation/mercy appeal dated 28.04.2015 (Annexure P-6) has already been submitted to respondent No.2 and the same is pending consideration. He submits that let respondent No.2 be directed to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-6) within a specified time.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, if the petitioner has indeed made the representation/mercy appeal dated 28.04.2015 (Annexure P-6), and the same is actually pending consideration before the

Financial Commissioner (Taxation), Punjab Civil Secretariat, Chandigarh, the same shall be considered and decided in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order. It is made clear that this order shall not constitute any expression of opinion on the merits of the claim of the petitioner.
