On 30.6.2014, this Court passed the following order:-

“Counsel for the petitioner submits that he had misplaced the brief and, therefore, he is not in a position to make a statement as to whether an application for impleading the legal representatives of the petitioner has been filed by him or not. He prays for an adjournment.

Prayer granted.

In case, no application has been moved for impleading the legal representatives of the petitioner who is stated to have died during the pendency of the writ petition within a period of three months, the writ petition shall be deemed to have been dismissed for non-prosecution.

List for further consideration on 12.01.2015.”

Considering the order passed by this Court on 30.6.2014, as application for bringing on record the LRs of the deceased petitioner has not been filed within the period of three months, the writ petition already stood dismissed for non-prosecution. No further order is required to be passed.
