Application is disposed of.

Main case:

The petitioners herein are JBT Teachers serving under the Haryana State Education Department. All the petitioners assert themselves to be belonging to the reserved category.

The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for the issuance of a writ of mandamus for directing the respondent-authorities to strictly adhere to and to implement the instructions dated 15.07.2014 on the subject of grant of reservation in jobs under Government/Government undertakings and Local Bodies as well as in admission in Government/Government aided educational/technical/professional

institutions.

In the light of the prayer made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition itself without even going into the merits of the case and to grant liberty to the petitioners to approach the appropriate/competent authority under the State Government for the implementation of the instructions dated 15.07.2014 at Annexure P-13.

In the eventuality of any such representation being preferred, the State Government/appropriate authority would be obligated to consider the same and to take all such steps as may be warranted strictly in accordance with law.
