Petitioner was allotted three different works, details of which have been mentioned in para 2 of the writ petition, which were completed in the month of July, 2012 to the entire satisfaction and under the supervision of the officials of the respondents. Petitioner has been approaching the respondents for release of the monetary benefits, which it is entitled to, but no response has been received. Petitioner has filed a representation dated 07.04.2015 (Annexure P-2) to the Executive Engineer, Water Supply & Sanitation Division, Moga-respondent No.4 but no response thereto has been received nor any payments made to the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner at this stage would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.4 to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner, as has been projected in the representation dated 07.04.2015 (Annexure P-2) within some specified time.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present

writ petition is disposed of with directions to the Executive Engineer, Water Supply & Sanitation Division, Moga-respondent No.4, to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner dated 07.04.2015 (Annexure P-2), within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential benefits, if any, be released to it, in accordance with law, within a further period of one month. In case the claim of the petitioner is not to be accepted, a well reasoned and speaking order be passed and conveyed to it forthwith.
